Project Update & Notice of Works



A NEW PLAYGROUND AT HUGH JOHNSON BOULEVARD RESERVE

Hugh Johnson Boulevard Reserve Playground is a regional playground which is scheduled in the Playground Framework to be upgraded. In 2020 / 2021 the City of Marion consulted with residents on the playground upgrade at the Hugh Johnson Boulevard Reserve and Pond and Creek works. After incorporating resident feedback, the design for the playground was finalised.

The construction of the new playground, pump track, pond and creek reinstatement and associated works is due to commence from **17th January 2022** which includes removal of existing playground equipment. Urbans Landscape Construction will be undertaking the construction works.

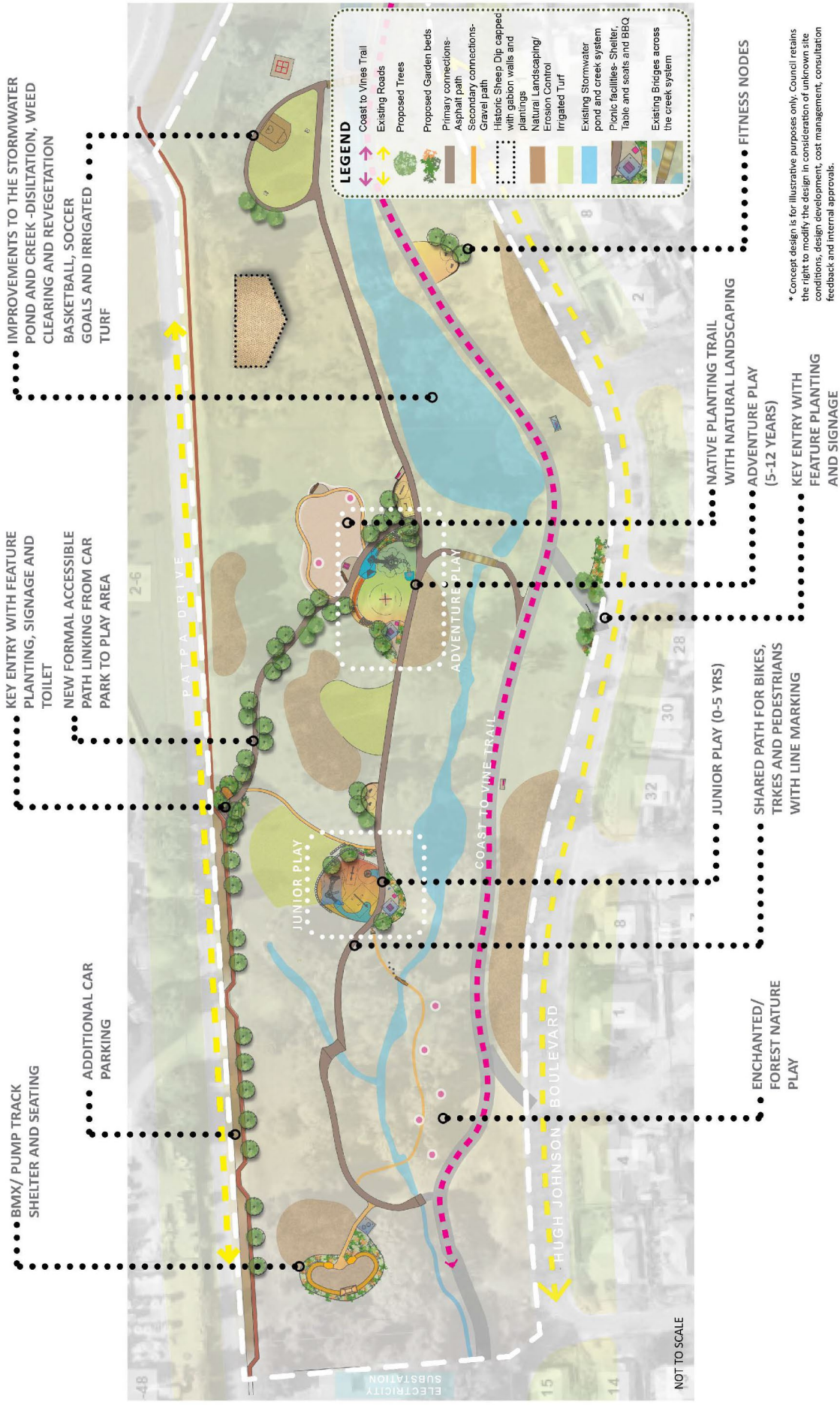
DESIGN

The design for the playground and associated works includes:

- New play equipment – Junior play unit, Swing set, Hurricane swing, Carousel, see-saw, Custom Tree House structure
- Fitness equipments
- Basketball and Netball posts and rings
- Junior Pump Track
- Shade sail
- Car parking along Patpa Drive
- Toilet
- Shared path for bikes, trikes and pedestrians
- Nature-based play – Timber logs and steppers, Boulders, timber bridge nature trail
- Picnic facilities – Shelter, BBQ, picnic tables, bike racks and drinking fountain
- Reinstatement of pond and creek
- Landscaping
