Basketball Court

Council recently resolved to investigate a suitable site for a 3v3 basketball court within 1000m of Stanley Street Reserve. We propose three options within these reserves.

Option A – McKellar Terrace Reserve

Option B - Denham Avenue Reserve - East

Option C - Denham Avenue Reserve - West

Chain Link Fence

The white chain link fence in the southern portion of McKellar Reserve is proposed to be removed. The fence is in poor condition and the trees are mature enough to prevent cars driving on the reserve.

The fence around the playground portion will be retained.

Natural Landscaping and Furniture

Funds will be invested in a revegetation plan to improve the biodiversity and amenity of the reserves. New reserve furniture will also be included.

- Two new picnic benches and a seat will be added to Denham Avenue Reserve as well as minor landscaping.
- The garden bed alongside the tennis court at McKellar Terrace Reserve will be planted with native shrubs and groundcovers.
- Kellett Avenue Reserve will be planted with native trees and shrubs and a pathway mirroring the desire line though the reserve will be formalised
