Street Character Zones


The suggested lists align with tree species recommendations within the <u>City of Marion Tree Asset Management Plan 2024-2034</u>. The Asset Management Plan divides the council area into four distinct zones based on local character, soil conditions, climate and rainfall.

For best results we encourage you to choose species suited to the zone in which your property is located.

V-shaped form Vibrant fuchsia/red flower clusters, foliage orange through autumn

A small, ornamental very dark purple summer foliage. Single pink flowers in spring

Small – medium drooping, willowlike leaves and clusters of small white flowers.

Grows to 5 - 10 m

Medium-sized tree with pinnate leaves that turn red in autumn.

Grows to 8-15 m

Red cottonwood, native hibiscus

Hardy tree with a broad low crown, large heartshaped leaves and bright sunny yellow flowers.

Grows to 5 - 8 m

Small tree. Serrated, green leaves and drooping branches weeping effect.

Grows to12 – 20 m

Grows to 4-10 m

Grows to 5 - 10 m

Small – medium tree known for its vibrant autumn colours. white flowers




Hardy tree with a broad low crown, large heartshaped leaves and bright sunny yellow flowers.

Grows to 12-20 m

Large, hardy tree with rough bark and small, dark green leaves.

Grows to 20-25 m

Goolwa Gem Yellow Gum Eucalyptus leucoxylon 'Goolwa Gem'



Medium - large tree with yellow flowers and smooth bark.

Grows to 10-15 m

Evergreen

Yellowbox Eucalyptus melliodora



Medium to Large with unusual bark which varies from smooth to rough

Grows to 10-15 m

Small tree with weeping branches and fragrant leaves

Grows to 4-10 m

V-shaped form Vibrant fuchsia/red flower clusters, foliage orange through autumn

Grows 3 m

Evergreen Ash *Fraxinus griffithii*



Fast growing, drought tolerant, leaves that are green and shiny on the top and hairy silver coloured underneath.

Grows 4-8 m

Bella pink Brachychiton

Brachychiton populneus x acerifolius



small to medium sized green foliage and pretty clusters of pink, bell-shaped flowers in Summer

Grows 4-8 m

Small – medium drooping, willowlike leaves and clusters of small white flowers.

Grows to 5 - 10 m

Tuckeroo *Cupaniopsis anacardoides*



Medium sized coastal tree with glossy leaves and small yellow flowers.

Grows to 8-15 m

Golden Rain Tree Koelreuteria sp.



Small tree. Serrated, green leaves and drooping branches weeping effect.

Grows to 5 - 8 m

Chinese Elm Ulmus parvifolia



A fast growing, with a broad vase-shape Small dark green leaves.

Grows 5-12 M

Large, hardy tree with rough bark and small, dark green leaves.

Grows to 10-20 m

Eucalyptus leucoxylon 'Goolwa Gem'



Medium - large tree with yellow flowers and smooth bark.

Grows to 10-15 m

Evergreen

Coral Gum Eucalyptus torquate



Medium - Large tree with coral-Coloured flowers and rough bark.

Grows to 6-10 m

Callistemon 'Kings Park Special'



Vigorous, small shrub with large, bright red bottlebrush flowers.

Grows to 2-4 m

Red cottonwood, native hibiscus

Hardy with a broad low crown, large heart-shaped leaves and yellow flowers.

Grows to 5 - 8 m

Evergreen

Willow Myrtle Agonis flexuosa



Small – medium drooping, willowlike leaves and clusters of small white flowers.

Grows to 5 - 10 m

Evergreen

Drooping Sheoak

Allocasuarina verticillata



Medium tree with drooping branchlets and fissured bark. Leaves are reduced to scales.

Grows to 5-9 m

Tuckeroo

Cupaniopsis anacardoides



Medium sized coastal tree with glossy leaves and small yellow flowers.

Grows to 6-15 m

Evergreen

Todd Chinese Elm Ulmus parvifolia Todd'



Medium-sized tree. Suitable as a shade tree with serrated leaves and exfoliating bark.

Grows to 6-15 m

Deciduous

Mallee Box Eucalyptus porosa



Medium - Large tree with rough bark, Cream fowers and glossy green leaves.

Grows to 10-15 m

Evergreen

Coral Gum *Eucalyptus torquate*



Medium - Large tree with coral-Coloured flowers and rough bark.

Grows to 6-10 m

Evergreen

Goolwa Gem Yellow Gum Eucalyptus leucoxylon 'Goolwa Gem'



Medium - large tree with yellow flowers and smooth bark.

Grows to 10-15 m

Evergreen

European Hackberry

Celtis australis



Large, hardy tree with rough bark and small, dark green leaves.

Grows to 10-20 m

Deciduous
